Cut your water bill with these easy tips:

Heating the water in your home can account for up to 20% of your utility bill – often making it the second largest energy expense in your home. A few simple adjustments can help lower your monthly bill by cutting hot water use. Try these tips:

- Showers, not baths. Taking a bath uses 12-25 gallons of hot water. It takes less than 10 gallons for a five-minute shower.
- Cold water. Turn your washing machine's setting to "cold." Today's laundry detergents work well in cooler temperatures.
- **Full loads.** Only use your dishwasher when it's full. This will use less water than washing dishes by hand. Choose the shortest cycle needed to clean your dishes.
- Fix leaks. A seemingly minor leak of one drip per minute wastes 8.64 gallons of water per day.
- Turn your water heater down to 120° F. For every 10° reduction in temperature, you can save 3-5%.
- Install new showerheads. A low-flow showerhead can lower water heating costs by wasting less water. Pick up a free showerhead at the Columbia River PUD office in Deer Island.




