

Plan Ahead to Help Life Support Patients in Emergencies

Do you or someone you know use life support equipment, oxygenequipment, or have other special needs? If so, it's important to have a plan in case the power goes out.

Create a Personal Support Network and an Emergency Plan to have ready if needed. In an outage or other emergency, activate your Personal Support Network and Emergency Plan. These will help keep you comfortable until power is restored.

Columbia River PUD cannot estimate how long an outage will last. Every outage is unique. It's not always possible to estimate the extent of the damage or how long repairs will take. During outages,

PUD line crews work to safely restore power to all customers as quickly as possible.

Anytime you lose power, please report your outage to the PUD at **(503) 397-1844**. If it is an emergency, call **9-1-1**.




