The Area Agency on Aging has advised the centers that they are to suspend congregate meals until Phase 3 of our county's reopening. Once our county has reached Phase 3 we may consider a gradual reopening. Local meal sites are to ensure all safety precautions are taken including physical distancing, limiting the number of people, regular sanitizing of surfaces and use of face coverings by staff and volunteers. 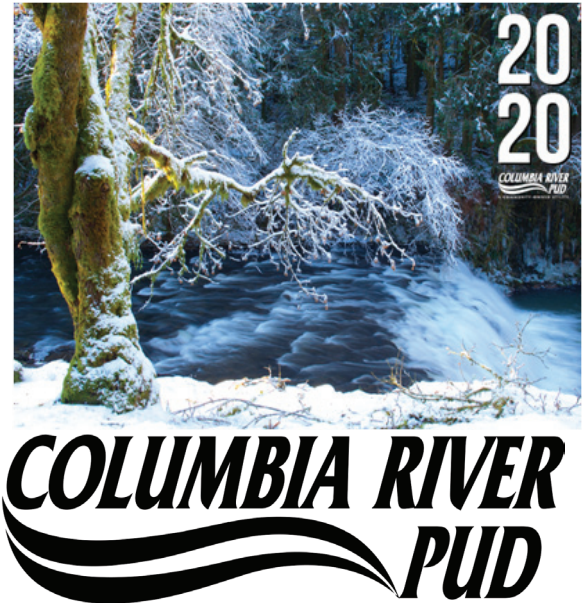
