Please Stay Safe from Scam Attempts

Please be wary of scam artists posing as Columbia River PUD employees.

Scammers will call or text message customers and threaten to shut off their power unless payment is made immediately. This is not something the PUD does.

Columbia River PUD will always make multiple attempts to contact you before your power is disconnected for late payment; however, the PUD does not send text message alerts for pending disconnection.

If you ever receive a phone call like this and you are unsure whether it's a PUD employee, please hang up and call the PUD at (503) 397-0590.

Do not be fooled by caller ID. Scammers can spoof the information to make it appear as though the call is coming from Columbia River PUD.

Never give out personal information about your bank account, credit card, or PUD account unless you have verified that the call is legitimately from the PUD.

The PUD also asks that you report any scam attempts to the PUD and to local police.












