Know What to Do If Your Power Goes Out

1. Call your power company to report the outage. If you are a Columbia River PUD customer, **call (503) 397-1844**. Your call helps the PUD determine the extent and location of the outage so they can restore power quickly.

2. Turn on a front porch light switch. This helps let PUD crews easily know when power is restored. Turn on a lamp inside your home so you'll know also.

3. Unplug sensitive electronic equipment and turn off large appliances like electric furnaces and water heaters at the breaker.

4. If you have access to a generator, please operate it safely. Do not run gasoline-powered generators indoors.

5. Keep a Home Emergency Kit ready. Include two weeks' worth of food and water for every member of your family, including pets.

So, PLEASE, fill out a NAPIS and complete side one and two. Names are NOT used in the collection process.
