Protect Your Home from Wildfire

Wildfires in the Pacific Northwest have increased in frequency and severity the last couple of years.

With this year's dry spring and predicted drought, many people are wondering if we may see a repeat of last year's devastating wildfire season.

Although we can't predict the future, Columbia River PUD is taking action to prepare for the summer months. Determining ways to mitigate fire danger has become a growing priority for electric utilities.

You can help keep yourself safe. Here are a few things you can do to help protect your home from wildfires:

- Create a 30-foot non-combustible buffer around your home
- Stack firewood away from your home.
- Clean gutters before fire season and keep them free of debris.

• Dispose of yard debris safely. This may mean composting, recycling, or chipping instead of burning.

• Trim branches along your driveway and your home.
