Please be wary of scam artists posing as Columbia River PUD employees.

Scammers will call or send a text message threatening to shut off a customer's power unless payment is made immediately. This is not something CRPUD does.

CRPUD will always make multiple attempts to contact you if your power is scheduled to be disconnected for non-payment. The PUD does not send text message alerts for pending disconnection.

If you ever receive a phone call and are unsure whether it's a PUD employee, please hang up and call the PUD directly at (503) 397-0590.








