Clean energy supports the region's clean air and water

The largest source of clean power in the United States is hydropower. Hydropower is fueled by rain and snow, making it a clean fuel and renewable source.

Hydropower accounts for 90% of renewable energy in the Pacific Northwest and almost half of all renewables in the US.

Because it's fueled by water, the Northwest's hydro base does not produce air pollution, avoiding the equivalent greenhouse gas emissions of more than 10 million cars on the road. This allows our Northwest community to enjoy outdoor activities like hiking, biking, boating, or skiing without worrying about air quality or visibility due to smog.

Did you know? Without hydropower, the United States would have to burn an additional 121 million tons of coal, 27 million barrels of oil, and 741 billion cubic feet of natural gas combined.









Opening Details Please Read Carefully

Hey everyone it's time to get together again! The Senior Center is having a re-opening on St. Patrick's Day, March 17th. There are some changes that you will have to keep in mind:

FIRST, you **MUST** wear a mask into the building. With the exception of unvaccinated folks, once seated you may remove your mask. If you are unvaccinated you may remove your mask only to eat. Masks must be worn to move around, i.e. going to the restroom.

SECONDLY, please do not help the servers. In the past we have always appreciated the diners helping by taking their plates to the table to be cleaned but now the servers only must be responsible for this.

THIRDLY, if you need more water or coffee, please let your server know. Do not get this yourself.

LASTLY, reservations will be required for a while. If you plan to eat with us or take out on the 17th, then you MUST call in no later than 3/9/22.

For those of you who do not feel comfortable coming into the center, we will still offer take out meals but you must let the center know when you call in.

On our regular days, please call to make reservations TWO days in advance and again let the front desk know if this is for onsite or take out.

of Us will be playing on our opening and we will have door prizes. Then The 3 of Us will play every Monday. Marily is working on scheduling music for the other days. Wendy will be cooking up some wonderful meals for us.
