Free Ways to Cut Heating Waste

Cold weather forces your heating system to work more, even if you don't adjust the temperature inside your home. That can increase your power bill. Here are a few suggestions from Columbia River PUD that can help you keep your bill lower during the cold winter months:

■ Keep your windows and doors closed to keep the heat in. This includes interior doors to garages and unheated basements.

■ Open blinds and shades on windows that are facing the sun. This allows the sun to warm your home.



■ Close blinds and drapes on windows that don't get direct sunlight. This will help keep heat from escaping.

■ **Help the warm air flow** by keeping decorations, appliances, furniture, and other items from blocking your heating registers.

Clean or replace your furnace filters on a regular basis.

Clogged filters make furnaces work harder to distribute heat, which increases costs and shortens the life of your equipment.


