Get Ready for Winter Weather

We have officially entered fall, which means cold weather isn't far away.

Columbia River PUD has some tips to maximize your home's energy savings before winter arrives:

- Use a programmable thermostat to turn down the heat a few degrees when you're away.
- Check your home's insulation, especially in the attic. At least 6 inches of insulation is recommended in your attic.
- Service your heating system annually and change your furnace filter regularly.
- Fix loose or disconnected ductwork to help heat your home more effectively.
- Seal leaks around windows and doors by using weatherstripping, caulking, or door sweeps to keep warm air inside your home.




