CRPUD Rates Will Change October 1

Columbia River PUD's rates are changing on October 1.

Beginning with bills rendered October 1, residential customers will see their bills go up \$4.50 per month. This is an increase in the monthly base charge, from \$18 to \$22.50. The energy charge will remain the same at 7.19ϕ per kilowatt hour.

The PUD continues to offer a discount to income-qualified seniors. Customers in this program will see their base charge increase from \$3.60 per month to \$4.50 per month. Seniors in this program will also continue to receive a 10% discount on their energy charge.

Once the new rates go into effect, the average CRPUD residential customer's monthly bill will be about 18% lower than the statewide average and almost 40% lower than the national average.


