Call Before You Dig

Do any of your spring projects require digging? If they do, Columbia River PUD reminds you to call 8-1-1 before breaking ground. Whether you are planting a tree, digging a garden bed, or installing a fence, call 8-1-1 first. This free service will help locate underground utility lines.

Call at least two days before digging and tell them where you plan to dig. A locator will identify underground wires, cables, and pipes so you'll know what's below. This helps keep you safe.

It also helps prevent disruptions to vital services.


