Plan Ahead to Help Life Support Patients in Emergencies

If someone in your home is on life support or has other special needs, have a plan in place for storms, power outages, or other emergencies. If you lose power, report your outage to Columbia River PUD at (503) 397-1844. If it is an emergency, always call 9-1-1.

To be prepared, you should create a Personal Support Network and an Emergency Plan. In an outage or other emergency, activate your Personal Support Network and Emergency Plan. These will help keep you comfortable until power is restored. The PUD cannot estimate how long an outage will last. Every outage is unique. It's not always possible to estimate the extent of the damage or how long repairs will take. During outages, PUD line crews will work to safely restore power to all customers as quickly as possible.


