


May is Board nomination time. If you're interested in a Board position or would like to nominate someone, please get the form at the front desk, complete it and return it to the front desk.

#### **Practice DMV Test Available**


DMV is offering a sample written test to Rainier senior residents if you need to renew your driving license. Sample tests can be found at:
