CRPUD Office Hours Changing in January

Columbia River PUD's office hours will change on January 2, 2018. The PUD's new hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Thursday. The office will be closed on Fridays.

CRPUD linemen will still be available for outage response 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Customers will be able to access their account and pay their bill online or by phone, any time.

A recent customer survey showed the PUD could meet the needs of 86% of customers by opening its office longer hours, four days a week. The PUD office is currently open 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday. According to the survey, the existing schedule meets the needs of 74% of customers.

"Many of the customers surveyed wanted to be able to do business with us outside of their own work hours," said PUD General Manager John Nguyen. "This change makes that possible, so it gives us the chance to meet the needs of more customers."


